How many train stations does Pristina have?

Pristina effectively has two train stations: Pristina railway station lies west of the center near the end of Str. Garibaldi, while Fushë Kosovë railway station is Kosovo's main railway hub. Pristina is served by one daily train to Skopje.

Where to buy a train ticket in Pristina (Kosovo)?

Note: in some countries you have to pay a service fee at the ticket counter.

How to get to Pristina?

Tourists coming to the Pristina bus station can reach the city via the local bus no. 7, which they can hop on at the entrance of the bus station (by the roundabout). This bus line comes from the bus station towards the city center (or Mother Teresa Boulevard). The ticket costs 0.50 euros one-way, and you pay it to the bus conductor.
