How many 5G base stations are there in India?

India had 469,000 5G base stations at the end of February, according to the latest available figures from the country's Ministry of Communications. The ministry said the number of active 5G subscribers in the country surpassed 250 million in the period - in less than two and a half years since 5G was commercially launched.

How many 5G BTS have been deployed in India?

The deployment of 5G Base Transceiver Stations (BTS) by the operators in India has seen a growth of over 60,000 from July 2nd to August 28th. This means that since the last time we covered 5G BTS, a total of 63,316 BTS have been deployed across all states and Union Territories, according to the Department of Telecommunications (DoT).

Indian telecom operators have deployed over 60,000 5G Base Transceiver Stations in the past month, taking the total number of 5G BTS in the country to over 338,000.
