# Tokyo solar panel prices

How much do solar panels cost in Japan?

The government encourages new detached houses to install solar panels, and subsidies greatly help reduce the costs of installing solar panels. Currently, the average price for a solar panel in Japan ranges from 200,000 to 400,000 yen per kilowatt(kW). Are there subsidies for installing solar panels in Japan?

Will Tokyo subsidize solar panels?

In March last year, the Tokyo Metropolitan Government established a 150 billion yen fund to subsidize the installation of solar power generation equipment for Tokyo residents. Subsidies will be provided if solar panels are installed during the construction of new eco-friendly houses or while retrofitting existing houses with insulation.

Should you install solar panels in Tokyo?

Installing solar panels not only reduces monthly electricity bills but also ensures power availability during outages. Check the conditions and see how much subsidy you can receive. Tokyo will require solar panel installation on new homes starting April 2025.

How many kW is a solar panel in Japan?

5kW is the national average for installing solar panels in a home in Japan. The amount varies depending on the region and the property's roof size. The maximum for a household is 10kW. Do I need a storage battery with solar panels? While not necessary, storage batteries are highly recommended.
